Sight Seeing

Old Manila

Manila has been one of the worlds best preserved medieval cities. Dungeons and old churches share space with art galleries, theaters, Nature Park. Manila Cathedral and San Agustin Church, Baroque Churches are the oldest fortifications of Intramuros(Old city of Manila).

Tagaytay City

Sixty-five kilometers southwest of Manila is the mountain city of Tagaytay. It is about 700 meters above sea level, overlooking the panoramic Taal lake and volcano. Enroute to Tagaytay are fruit orchards, sugar cane fields and coffee

plantations.

Taal Lake

Taal Lake is a freshwater lake in the province of Batangas, on the island of Luzon, Philippines. The lake is situated within a caldera formed by very large eruptions between 500,000 and 100,000 years ago. It is the countrys third largest lake. It is also home to the famous Taal volcano.

Taal Volcano

Taal Volcano is an active stratovolcano on the island of Luzon in the Philippines. It is situated between the towns of Talisay and San Nicolas in Batangas. It consists of an island in Lake Taal, which is situated within a caldera formed by an earlier, very powerful eruption. It is located about 50 km from the capital, Manila.
