##### Day 01 : India – Colombo - Kandy

Arrive Colombo and transfer to your hotel in Kandy. Evening visit the Temple of the Tooth Relic and thereafter witness a cultural show. Dinner & Overnight at the hotel.

##### Day 02 : Kandy - Nuwara Eliya

After early breakfast at the hotel, checkout from the hotel and transfer to Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage. Later proceed for a city tour of Kandy- the last capital of the Sri Lankan Kings. The name Kandy conjures visions of a storied past, splendour, legend, folklore, mystery and traditions lovingly kept alive for countless years. Visit a Gem museum and a lapidary. Transfer to Nuwara Eliya and check in at the hotel in Nuwara Eliya. Dinner & overnight at the hotel.

##### Day 03 : Nuwara Eliya

After breakfast, proceed to visit the Tea Plantation and a Tea Factory. Later visit the sites, which signifies higher historical, religious and cultural values; the Sitha Amman Kovil/temple, Temple dedicated to Hanuman and Hakkala Botanical Gardens. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

##### Day 04 : Nuwara Eliya – Colombo

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Colombo, enroute St Clare's and Devon water fall's. Arrive and check in to your hotel in Colombo. In the afternoon do a city tour of Colombo. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

### Sight Seeing

#### • Colombo

Visit the Colombo Fort and bazaar areas, the Old Parliament Complex, Independence Square and other famous attractions

#### • Kandy

Temple of the Tooth Relic, culture show: In the evening visit the Temple of the Tooth Relic and thereafter witness a cultural show Elephant Orphanage at Pinnawela, City Tour: Home to about 60 elephants found abandoned or orphaned in the wild. Also accompany the elephants to a close by river to see them having their daily baths

#### • Nuwara Eliya

Tea Factory & Tea Plantation: It is also the heart of Sri Lankas tea region, producing 50% of the worlds best tea. No trip to the city is complete without a visit to one of the many tea factories scattered around the surrounding mountains. Get to see how tea makes it from the field to the cup, and sample some of the freshest tea you are ever likely to drink. Sita Amman Temple, Hanuman Temple Hakkgala Botanical Gardens: It lies under the Hakgala Peak, between 5000 - 6000 feet in elevation - the highest set Botanic Gardens in the world. It boasts 100 year old Monetary Cypress trees from California, Japanese Cedars, Himalayan Pines and English Oak.
